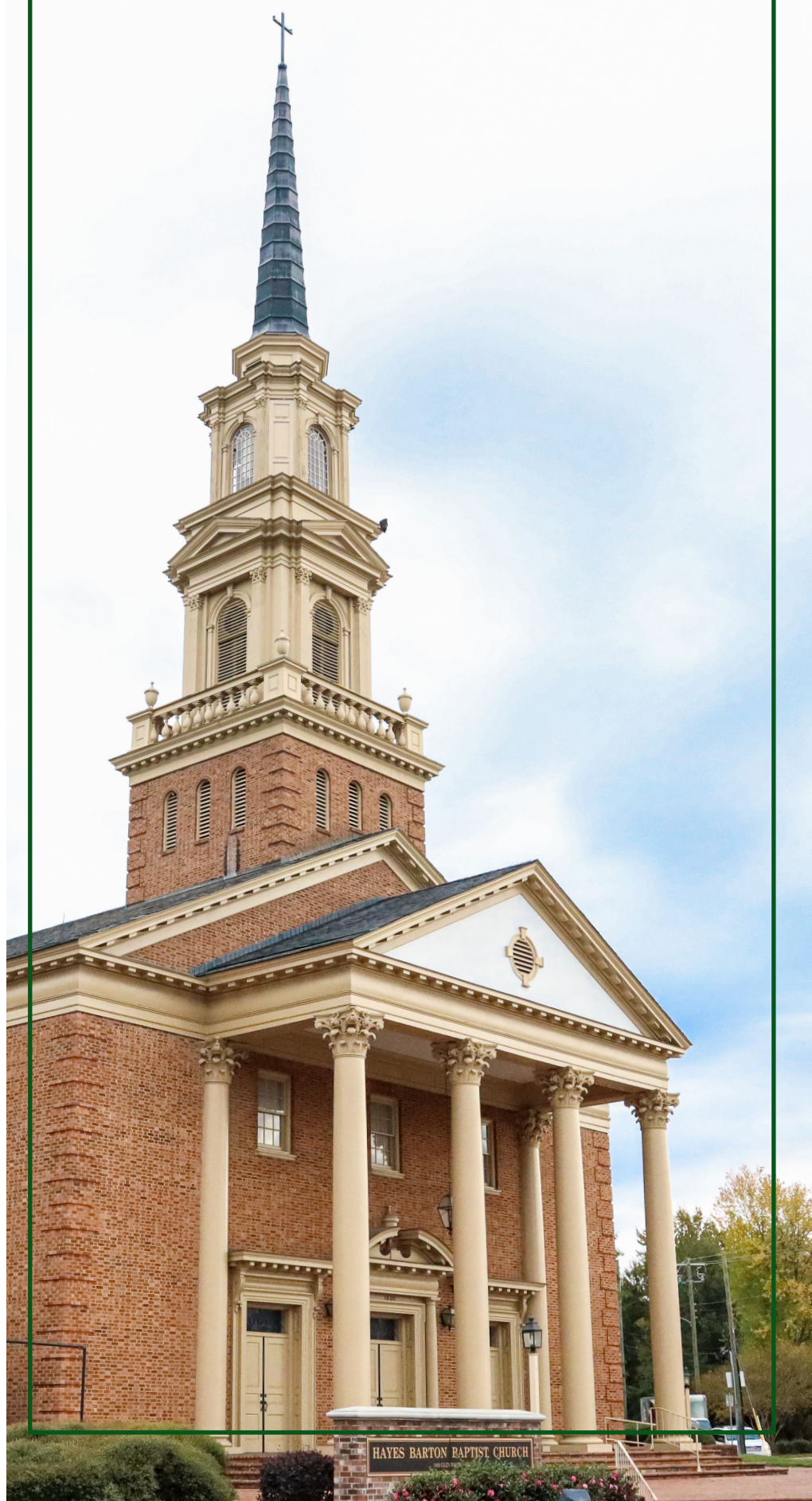

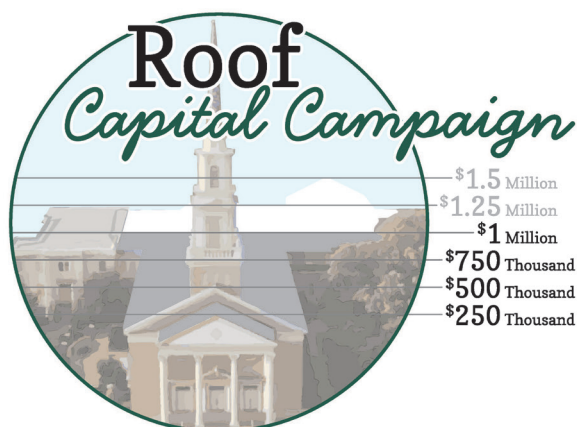

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Work is underway to replace the roof and gutters of our Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and main Education Building. This project, estimated to cost \$1.5 million, should be completed by the end of the summer. To fund this essential project, we are inviting members and friends of the church to make financial commitments to this project to be paid over three years. We are requesting that these contributions be over and above their financial support of our church budget.
