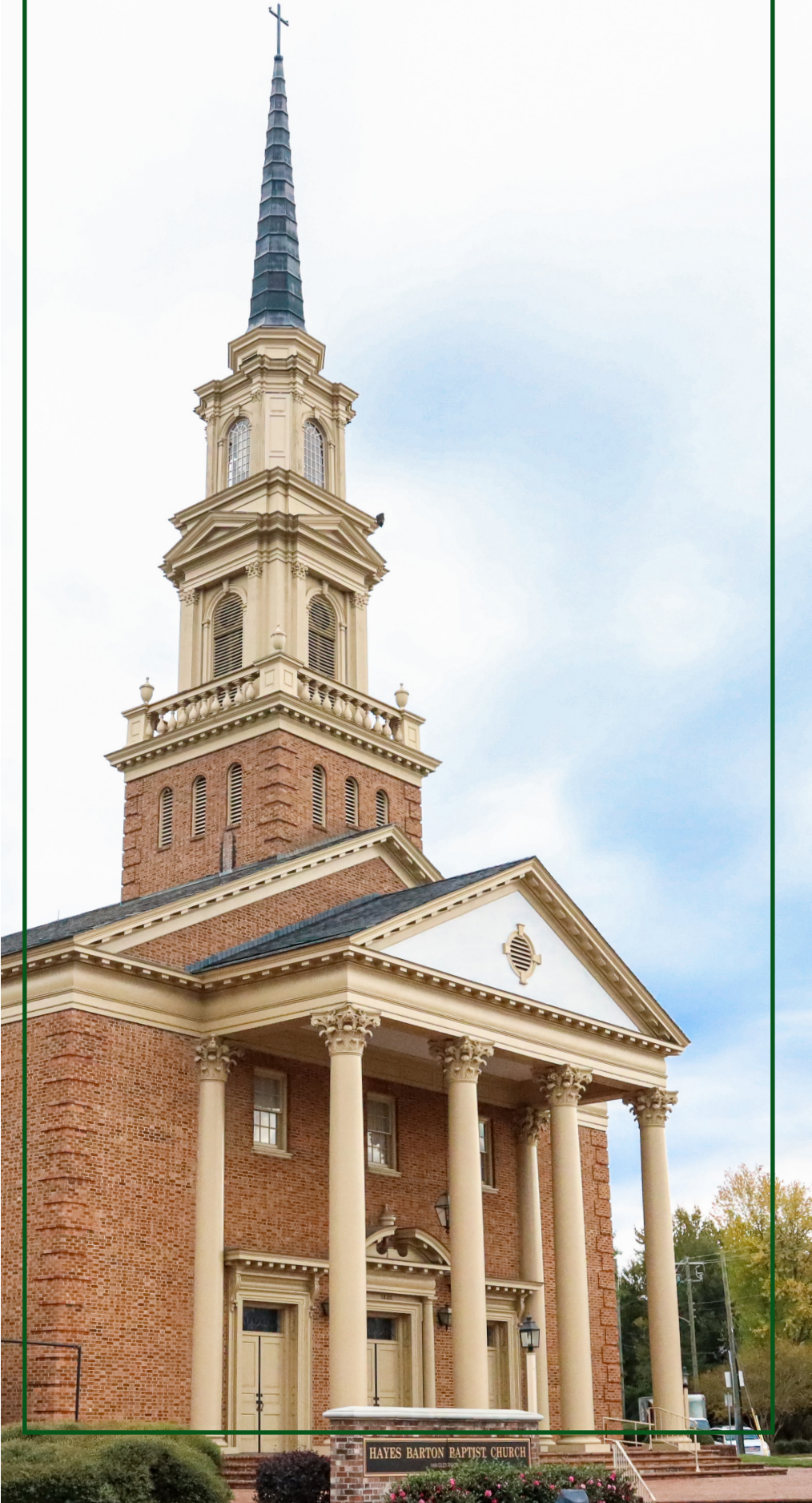

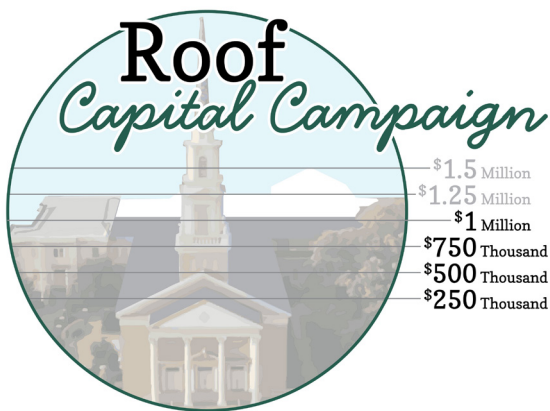

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Work is already underway to replace the roof and gutters of our Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and main Education Building, estimated to cost \$1.5 million. To fund this essential project, we are inviting members and friends of the church to make financial commitments to be paid over three years.
