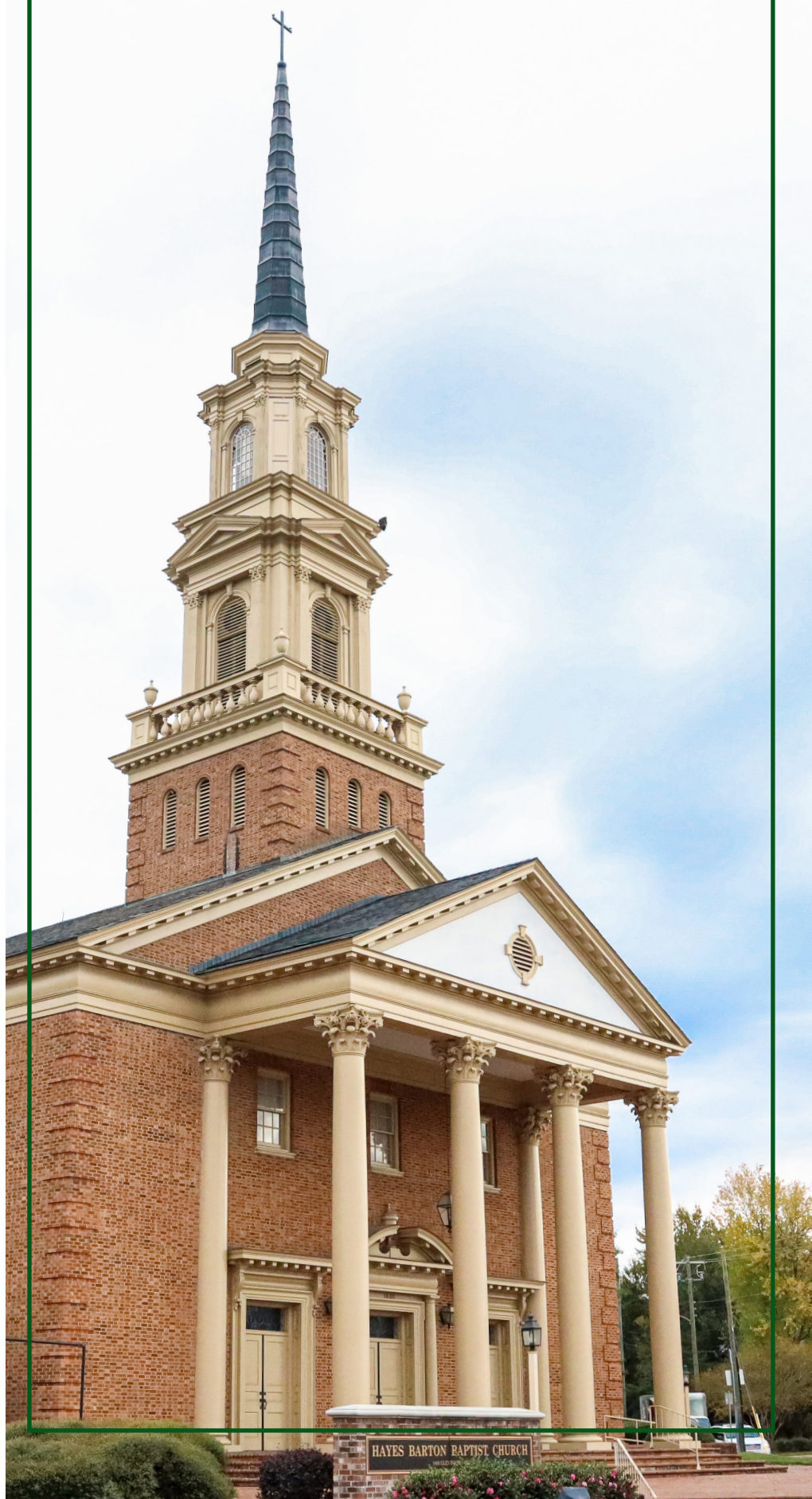

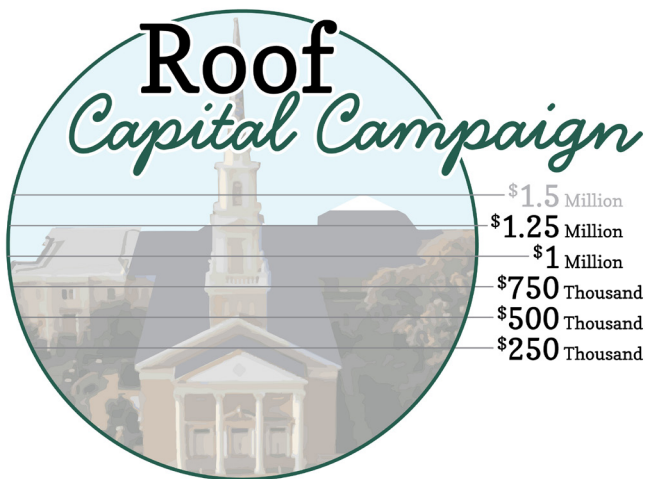

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Work is already underway to replace the roof and gutters of our Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and main Education Building, estimated to cost \$1.5 million. To fund this essential project, we are inviting members and friends of the church to make financial commitments to be paid over three years. We ask that you prayerfully consider your financial commitment to be over and above the regular budget and return your completed commitment card as soon as possible.
