HBBC began its Prayer Shawl Ministry in 2011, and we are now going into the 14th year. We knit and crochet shawls, lap blankets, scarves, etc. Upon completion, a label is sewn into the piece that says, "A Hug from God" and then members of the prayer shawl ministry lay hands on the piece and pray for the recipient of the shawl. It is a very short, but spiritual experience. The blessed item is then delivered to someone in need of comfort and solace. Some of the pieces are delivered by our ministers when they visit the sick or the homebound. Others are delivered by members of the congregation. If you do not know how to knit or crochet, we will help you get started. We have a supply of yarns and patterns and members who are very willing to teach.
