MONTHLY LUNCHEON

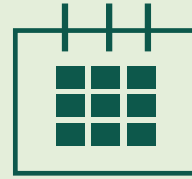
IN-PERSON | Tuesday, September 23 at 12:00 PM in Hailey Hall
