In anticipation of her Centennial Anniversary in 2026, Hayes Barton Baptist Church will host a year-long celebration of our glorious past, present, and future. The kickoff event for these activities takes place on Sunday, November 2 with Festival Sunday during the 11:00 AM service. Later that day, a BBQ supper catered by Parker's BBQ will be served in the Family Life Center at 5:00 PM, complete with pulled pork, fried chicken, potatoes, slaw, green beans, macaroni and cheese, Brunswick stew, hush puppies, corn sticks, tea, lemonade, and a special dessert.

Following the meal, we will move to Hailey Hall to enjoy an encore presentation of Five Points Junction — a hilarious retelling of the beginnings of our church's story. Under the direction of master storyteller Jeff Brooks, the evening will feature comedy sketches, a jazz combo straight from the 1920s, and music from some of our own home-grown talent. This will truly be a night to remember.

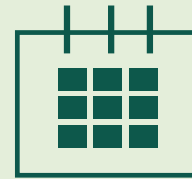
