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CASHWELL

The Cashwell Sunday School class is a welcoming class that is composed of adults who study, fellowship, and serve together. For years, they have provided meals on Christmas and Thanksgiving Day, as well as a monthly meal at the Helen Wright Women's Center. The class is made up of adults whose children are now moving out into the world to work. Several in the class are grandparents. They use a variety of resources to engage their faith and grow in their understanding of Scripture and God. Teachers rotate each week.

DANIELSON

This class provokes thinking outside of the box, engages in rigorous study and discussion of the radical life and teachings of Christ, and probes what that means for changes in our lives today. They do so with the basic Baptist principles such as the Priesthood of the Believer, the separation of church and state, and the autonomy



of the local church, all of which are dependent on individual exploration and thought. The class is quite large, diverse in age, beliefs, and opinions, and is committed to allowing members to express themselves freely in a respectful environment. The curriculum is derived from the Bible using multiple resources and books. Teachers rotate weekly.

FELLOWSHIP

The Fellowship Class, whose members have retired, personifies its name. No longer burdened with job schedules and other duties, the class members enjoy the company of one another and the opportunity to visit and study together. The class is taught by four teachers in a rotation. They bring to the class a variety of teaching experience and styles which make for interesting lessons and insights. Class starts at 9:45 AM, but members begin gathering 15 to 20 minutes earlier for visiting and fellowship.

CORNERSTONE

The Cornerstone Class is a growing group of young adults finding God's purpose and direction in their individual lives through shared Bible study, service opportunities, and meaningful Christian fellowship. Weekly lessons focus on applying scriptural precepts to our everyday circumstances in a manner that increases spiritual growth and understanding. They use a broad range of study materials which include topics in personal faith disciplines, service and missions in God's Kingdom, foundational doctrines of our faith, Bible books and characters, and joyful living in Christian community. Central to the purpose of this class is establishing faith foundations early in adult life in order to live faithfully and successfully in both the joys and trials of life ahead.

GENESIS

The Genesis class is a unique blend of individuals and couples. Many members have children in high school and college, as well as those that have graduated from college. Using a variety of resources, the class enjoys discussing the Bible, as well as applying topics and Scripture to life experiences. They are also involved in fellowship and service opportunities.

HAILEY

A class for couples (most, but not all, have children). They care deeply about each other, the church, and furthering their relationships with Jesus as they grow as Christians together. Using Scripture-based studies that involve group discussions, a team of teachers rotate each week.

UNITY

The Unity Class is a welcoming group of singles and couples in their 30s and 40s, many with young children. Each week features rotating teachers and a mix of deep Bible study and open discussion, encouraging thoughtful engagement and real-life application. Unity is a place to grow in faith, ask meaningful questions, and build lasting relationships—both on Sunday mornings and throughout the week.

KOINONIA

This class reflects its name; they offer fellowship, relationships, and the study of Biblical lessons. Class discussions allow the sharing of experiences and learning from one another. They share. They serve. They laugh. They love. They are long-standing members and newer members. Most have children and grandchildren, but all are children at heart as they enjoy their community of faith together. The class begins with tasty goodies around 9:45 AM every Sunday.

MEMBERSHIP MATTERS

Offered in-person and virtually, Membership Matters is a 5-week session where we talk about what it means to follow Christ, what it means to be a member of a church, what it means to be a member of a Baptist Church, and what makes Hayes Barton its unique style of Baptist. Led by Susan Hailey, this class is a great way to get to know the Hayes Barton community and meet other newcomers. The class is offered at various times throughout the year.

REFLECTIONS

This class uses Upper Room's Daily Disciplines devotional as their guide. It is a seven-day-a-week spiritual journey through the lectionary, exploring areas that challenge, support, and articulate our faith. Reflections is a group of individuals from a varying range of backgrounds and ages that are led by various class facilitators. Reflections offers opportunities to share, to listen, to learn, to fellowship, to pray, and to be involved with each other for the betterment of each individual and our collective faith.

THE WELL

Are you thirsty; then come to the well. The Well is an intergenerational class made up of singles and couples, young and old. The class gathers for times of fellowship and supports one another through prayer during the week.

Open to all ages and walks of life, the Beatitudes Class is built on a foundation of love, grace, and service. They time together centers on the idea that if the gospel could be summed up in one word, that word would be LOVE. This class concludes at 10:30 AM each week.

PRESCHOOL AND GRADE SCHOOL CHILDREN

Sunday School is provided for all ages on Sunday mornings. During Sunday School, children learn stories from the Bible and how they apply to our lives today.

Infants-Age 2 / Preschool I | Chapel Wing, ground floor at 9:45 AM

A lead teacher and assistants use experiential center-based instruction.

Ages 3-Kindergarten / Preschool II | Family Life Center, main floor at 9:45 AM

A lead teacher and assistants use experiential center-based and hands on learning.

Grades 1-5 / Children's Division | Main Building, second floor at 9:45 AM

A lead teacher and assistants facilitate an active Bible study using Shine: Living in God's Light.

Following Sunday School, Extended Session is offered for infants through kindergartners during the 11:00 AM worship service. Extended Session is a time of play, crafts, and Bible stories provided by volunteers. Children of all ages are part of our worshiping congregation and are welcome in the Sanctuary on Sunday mornings. Worship bags are provided at each entrance to the Sanctuary on Sunday mornings.



In addition, Children's Church is held on the first, third, and fifth Sunday of every month during the school year. Following the children's sermon, 1st-5th graders leave for a time of worship and fellowship that is child-oriented.

SAFETY


In 2003, HBBC implemented a Child and Youth Protection Policy to ensure that we are doing everything in our power to protect both our children and our volunteers. The policy affirms our commitment to provide a safe place for our youth and children and provides specific guidelines for employees and volunteers. In November 2015, the deacons voted to approve changes to the Child and Youth Protection Policy, including a requirement that every volunteer working with children or youth complete an annual safety training and background check. We utilize a secure online resource called Protect My Ministry for our awareness training and background checks. In March 2020, the deacons voted to approve additional changes to the child protection policy, including provisions for overnight camps and retreats.




