BRITT FOUNDATION GIFT UPDATE

Many of you attended the recent presentation at The Gathering and learned of a new ministry and partnership for HBBC made possible by using a portion of the recent Britt Foundation gift. This opportunity is in collaboration with our current affordable housing partner, CASA, and The Hope Center at Pullen, for the development of a nine-unit apartment community on Sunrise Avenue to provide housing and support services for young people transitioning out of foster care. Based on a recommendation by the Britt Donation Task Force, the Finance Committee and the Diaconate also approved that the remaining funds from the Britt Foundation gift not used for the Sunrise project would be placed in a temporary, restricted account of the Church and managed by the Investment Committee.
