Excellent music has been and is a hallmark of worship at Hayes Barton Baptist Church. Talented instrumentalists and vocalists from the church membership, and as invited guests, have uplifted the congregation over the decades. On several occasions, well-known soloists have shared their talent in services. As part of HBBC's seventy-fifth-anniversary celebration on November 4, 2001, Ray Walker, a noted Broadway performer who was in town for the North Carolina Theater's production of *Evita*, sang a powerful version of "Find Us Faithful." In September 2005, Grammy Award winner Debby Boone [daughter of 1950s and '60s singer and actor Pat Boone], who was in Raleigh to play Guinevere in the North Carolina Theatre's presentation of *Camelot*, performed two songs during the Sunday morning service.

FEED THE HUNGER UPDATE

On Sunday, April 12, more than 160 children, youth, and adults gathered around tables in the gym to put together meals for children around the world. 27,600 meals were assembled and will be distributed in either Guatemala or Ghana to children in schools. This might be their only meal of the day. With the Centennial Offering that was designated during the Christmas Missions Offering, these meals have been paid for, and a Bible in the language of the children will be included with each box that is sent. Thank you for giving and serving so that others can experience the bread of life!

July 31-August 7

The partnership's primary purpose is to construct seminary buildings in Santa Clara, Cuba, as well as maintenance/construction at the retirement home in Santiago. THE GATHERING FOR ADULTS: HAPPINESS AND WELL-BEING

Adam Holland, Ph.D., a deacon at HBBC, will focus on happiness and well-being. We will discuss what the Bible teaches us about these ideas and how those teachings align with science and philosophy on the topic. Theoretical frameworks that we will draw from will include self-determination theory, mindfulness literature, and positive psychology.

Adam is an Implementation Specialist at the Frank Porter Graham Child Development Institute at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. His research interests include challenging behavior, adult and child well-being, and implementation science. He has served as Director of the North Carolina Early Learning Network, Research Director of the Abecedarian Education Foundation, and Chair of the International Early Childhood Inclusion Institute. His current projects focus on inclusive STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) in early childhood and helping the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services implement evidence-based innovations that benefit young children and their families. In his spare time, Adam enjoys napping and forgetting why he walked into a room.

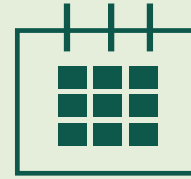
