SCHOOL OF MUSIC FALL REGISTRATION

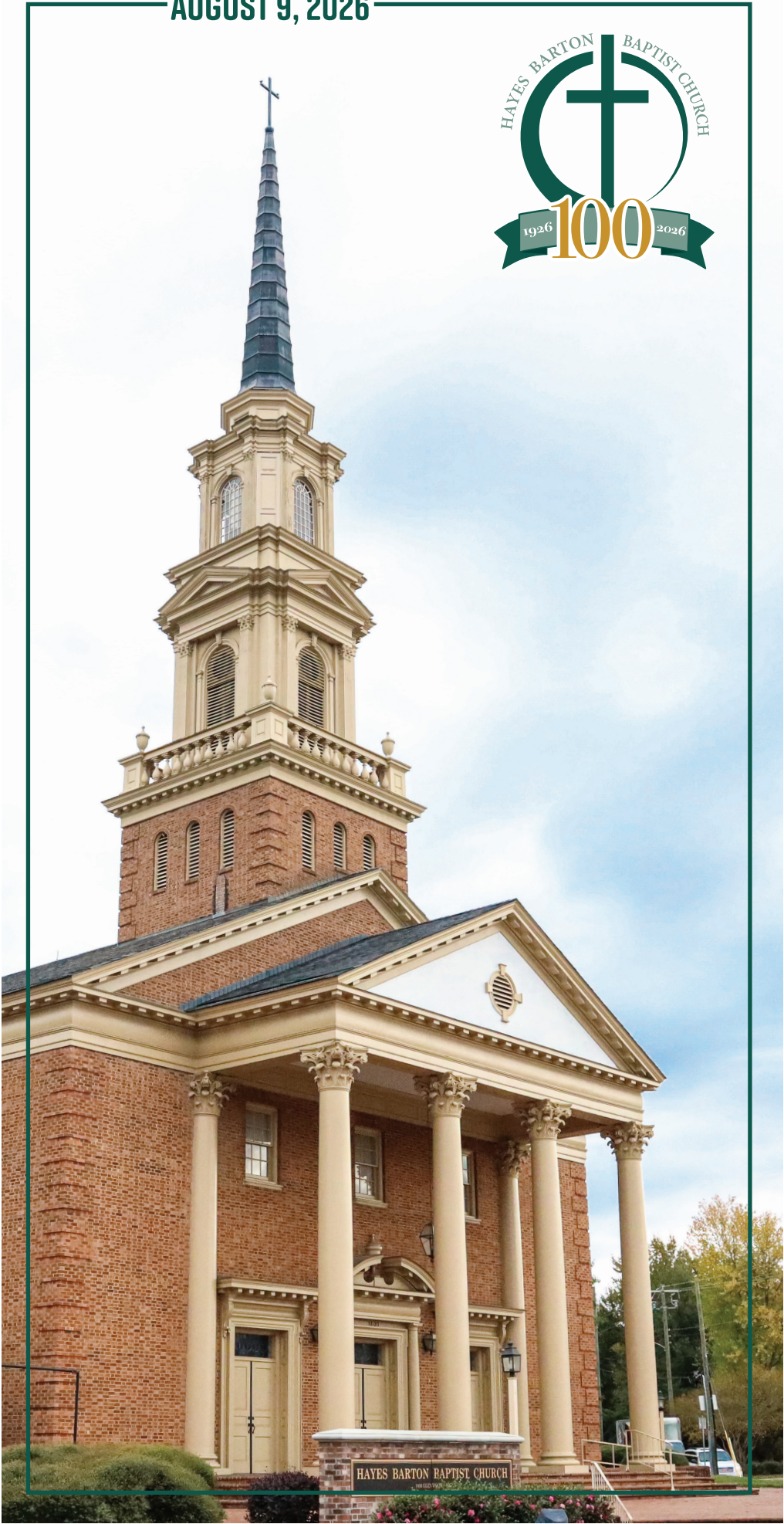
